State Senator Koehler announces 46th Legislative District General Assembly Tuition Waivers availability

SPRINGFIELD – State Senator David Koehler (D-Peoria) is announcing the availability of General Assembly Tuition Waivers for students residing in the 46th Legislative District. The Tuition Waivers will be distributed to eight students on a one year basis.

“The Tuition Waivers are a way to give students from the district who have shown a financial need and the drive to succeed, a good push forward in their academic career. The application process is complex and designed to put forth the best and brightest candidates who are in the most need,” Senator Koehler said.

The 46th Legislative District Tuition Waivers are available to students who reside in the 46th Legislative District and who have been accepted by one of the following Illinois State Universities:

- Chicago State University, Chicago
- Eastern Illinois University, Charleston
- Governor’s State University, University Park
- Illinois State University, Normal
- Northern Illinois University, DeKalb
- Western Illinois University, Macomb
- Northeastern Illinois University, Chicago
- Southern Illinois University (Carbondale and Edwardsville Campuses)
- University of Illinois (systemwide)
- University of Illinois College of Medicine (systemwide)

All applicants must reside in the 46th Legislative District. If you currently live at school, your home (away from school) address must be within the 46th Legislative District. Winners will be chosen by the 46th Legislative District Scholarship Committee based on financial need, overall academic performance, and community involvement.
